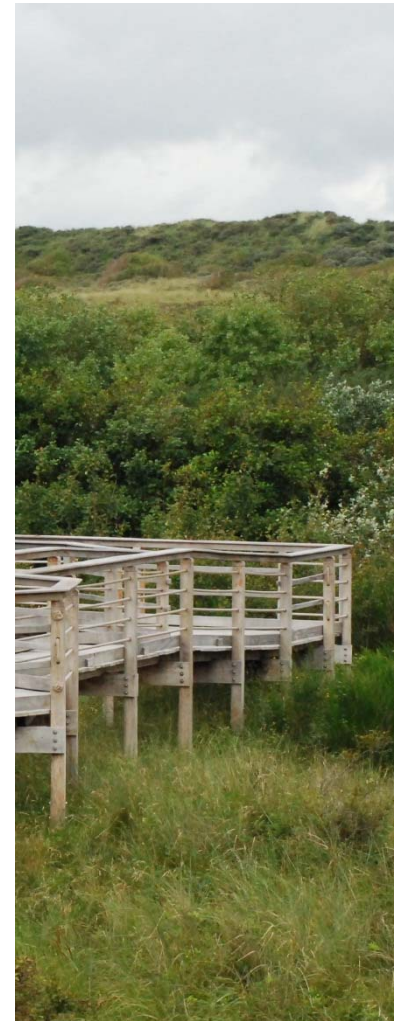

- Diversify communications (including web streaming!!!)



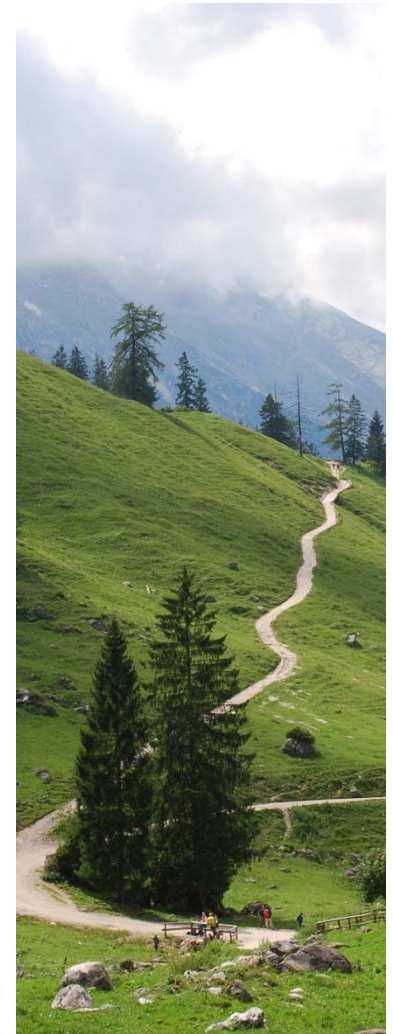
What the team takes home

- **Enabling conditions:**
 - look at different groups
 - finances and acknowledgement crucial
- **Governance:**
 - Link up with existing institutions
 - Transparency of processes
- **Relevance**
 - Be clear about the policy side
 - Specify the possible links to IPBES
- **Quality assurance:**
 - Different levels to be addressed
 - Quality of input
 - Quality of process, ...



What the team takes home

- **Different forms of knowledge:**
 - Integration across the whole NoK process
 - Role in assessments to be clarified case by case
- **Evidence-based approaches:**
 - Identify manageable questions
 - Use existing standards/ experiences
 - (check use of other approaches)
- **Building a Community of Interest:**
 - Step by step approach
 - Explore existing IT-solutions for specific needs
 - (no single general IT platform solution)
